



Permission and Indemnity Form

The safety of all participants is Mathcamp's highest priority. The following safety protocols will be in effect for the duration of the camp:

1. Access to the Mathcamp dormitory area will be limited to Mathcamp students and staff, college personnel, and authorized visitors. Outsiders will not be admitted. Students will be issued key rings and lanyards and required to keep their rooms locked at all times.
2. Students will be required to check in with a designated staff member between 8 pm and 11 pm every night and will not be allowed to leave the dormitory area after that time, unless accompanied by camp personnel.
3. Students will not be allowed to leave the college campus unless accompanied or given explicit authorization by camp personnel.
4. Each student will be assigned two staff advisors – one academic and one residential – who will be specifically responsible for the student's welfare. The advisors will maintain close daily contact with the student, and will meet with the student at least once a week to discuss academic progress as well as any other concerns.
5. In case of a medical problem or other emergency, the student's parents or guardians will be notified immediately, while at the same time prompt medical attention will be administered as required.

I, parent/guardian of _____, understand and certify that my child's participation in Mathcamp and its activities is completely voluntary. I recognize that certain hazards and dangers are inherent in Mathcamp events and programs, particularly but not limited to sports events, field trips, and other off-campus trips. I acknowledge that although Mathcamp has taken safety measures to minimize the risk of injury to camp participants, Mathcamp cannot insure nor guarantee that the participants, equipment, premises, and/or activities will be free of hazards, accidents, and/or injuries. I further recognize and have instructed my child in the importance of knowing and abiding by the camp's rules, regulations, and procedures for the safety of camp participants.

Having satisfied myself that the protocols for safety at Mathcamp represent due diligence on the part of the Mathematics Foundation of America (MFOA), I hereby indemnify MFOA, its directors, officers and employees, against any and all legal claims on behalf of this student, provided that MFOA has not failed to institute that protocol in respect of which the injury or accident occurred. Further, I agree that in the event of occurrence of any legal claims relating to this student and Mathcamp, the claims shall be only on the Mathematics Foundation of America, not its individual directors, officers or employees, and shall be limited to \$1,000,000 US.
