
After 30+ summers of seeing the transformational effects of this unique approach for our students, staff, and the world – we began asking:

How can we increase our impact?

Our planning process assessed the current state of MFOA and considered what role we should play in the ecosystem around us.



All indicators pointed to the **national need for more access to math enrichment**.



We then identified what is most integral to MFOA's work so that our plan would help meet this need while capitalizing on what **only we can do**. We've identified five interconnected goals, the first of which is:

More Mathcamp!

We will be **launching a second site of Mathcamp within the next five years**. This plan lays out a roadmap to simultaneously strengthen our existing program and systems, and to leverage our experience to benefit the broader math enrichment ecosystem. Just as each word in our mission statement had to earn its place: in this plan, each tactic, strategy, and goal directly serves that mission while staying true to MFOA's and Mathcamp's identities and values.

Goal 1

Double the number of students served at Mathcamp every year

Goal 2

Evolve and grow our organizational structure

Prepare for growth by examining and updating the systems that make MFOA and Mathcamp work while maintaining values of individual autonomy and consensus.

Goal 3

Strengthen the deep sense of belonging for all

Build more intentionality into our mathematical and social structures so that everyone who interacts with Mathcamp feels proactively welcomed into its incredible culture.

Goal 4

Define and build Mathcamp's profile as a catalyst

Build relationships to open new doors, both into Mathcamp and along the myriad pathways that our students and staff follow after camp. Show the impact and value of a Mathcamp experience.

Goal 5

Serve as a **driving force** in math enrichment

Pursue opportunities to leverage and share our deep expertise in pedagogy, community-building, and systems to benefit the math enrichment field at large and further our mission.
